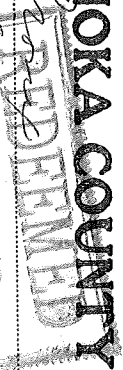


Gentlemen:—

I, the undersigned, civil engineer appointed to survey and superintend the construction of Ditch No. 47, of your County, would respectfully report that I have inspected the digging of the said ditch on the main line along Clear Water Creek, from Stations 50 to Station 55 both inclusive.

The said sections were sold to Joseph Leroux for the sum of \$80.00, but I found that the work would not be properly completed for that amount of money, so that more money was expended than the estimate called for. I would respectfully report that the said Stations are completed in a good, workmanlike manner and to the satisfaction of everybody interested, the actual cost of the said work was \$89.75. I would respectfully recommend that the sum of \$100 be paid to the said Joseph Leroux for this work. His contract for the work stated that he was to do \$64.00 worth of work for the sum of \$80. This amount of \$100 gives the said Joseph Leroux a little less than the said contract price. I would respectfully recommend that the said sum of \$100 be paid to Joseph Leroux for this work out of the general ditch fund of the said county according to law.

And I do hereby certify that no loss will result to the said county by the payment of the said amount on account of this work.
