

PRINTER'S AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(Chapter 134, Laws of 1955.)

~~ARTHUR P. BARK~~ F. G. Clasen, being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the ~~proprietor~~ editor of the newspaper known

as the Anoka County Union, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication

therein of the Notice of Hearing

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the City of Anoka, in the County of Anoka,

State of Minnesota, on Friday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five percent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local post office; that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Anoka County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper; and that a copy of each issue has been filed with the State Historical Society.

That the Notice of Hearing hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and

published in the English language, once each week for one successive weeks; that it was first so published on Friday, the 30th day of September 1960; and thereafter on _____ of each week

to and including the _____ day of _____ 19____; and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
