

NOTICE OF PENDENCY OF DITCH PETITION.

Whereas, the petition of Julius E. Hard and others, bearing date the 27th day of September, 1906, praying for the establishment of a public ditch and branches along the route proposed therein, has been filed in my office,

Now, Therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and considered by and before the board of county commissioners at their special meeting to be held at the court house in the city of Anoka in said county on the 10th day of December, 1906, at 11 o'clock A. M. A true copy of said petition is as follows, to-wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch ~~along the following described route in the Town of Centerville, in said county of Anoka hereinafter described,~~ would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a public ditch along the following described route in the Town of Centerville in said county of Anoka; that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit: That large quantities of land along the course of the proposed ditch are now wet, overflowed and rendered useless and of small value for farming purposes, which by the establishment and construction of the proposed ditch would be drained and rendered useful and of great value for farming purposes and others.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows: Commencing at a point on the east line of the east one-half of the southwest quarter of section No. 24, in township No. 31 and range 22, where Clearwater Creek so-called, crosses said line; thence running along the following route: following Clearwater Creek westerly, crossing part of said section 24 and part of section 23, all of town No. 31, range 22, and terminating at a point in said section 23, township thirty-one, range twenty-two, where the Centerville and Hugo road so-called, crosses said Clearwater Creek, on the south line of the north half of the northwest quarter of said section twenty-three, township thirty-one, range twenty-two, in said Clearwater Creek as its outlet, with such branch or branches as may be necessary and proper to render said ditch most effectual.



Commissioners of the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, do hereby give notice that a petition has been filed in said county on the 10th day of October, 1906, by Julius F. Hard and others, praying for the establishment of a public ditch along the route proposed therein, and that the same will be heard and considered by and before the County Auditor at their special meeting to be held at the office of said auditor on the 10th day of October, 1906. A true copy of said petition is as follows:

Whereas lands will be liable to be affected by the construction of the public ditch herein described, and whereas the construction of said ditch would result in the following described route in the County of Anoka, Minnesota, and is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit: That large quantities of land along the course of the proposed ditch are now wet, overflowed and rendered useless and of great value for farming purposes, which by the establishment and construction of the proposed ditch would be drained and rendered useful and of great value for farming purposes and others.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and termination of said ditch is as follows: Commencing at a point on the east line of section 24, in town 24, in range 28, where Clearwater Creek so-called, crosses said line; thence running along the following route: Following Clearwater Creek, crossing part of 24 and part of section 23, all of town No. 21, range 28, and terminating at a point in said section 23, township thirty-one, range twenty-two, where the Generville and Hugo road so-called, crosses said Clearwater Creek, on the south line of the north half of the northwest quarter of said section twenty-three, town-ship thirty-one, range twenty-two, in said Clearwater Creek as it exists with such changes or branches as may be necessary and proper to render said ditch most efficient.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such public ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by chapter two hundred and thirty (230) of the General Laws of Minnesota for 1905, and the laws amendatory thereto and supplementary thereto.
