Whereas the petition of Julius E. Hand and others bearing date the 27th day of September 1906 praying for the establishment of a public ditch and branches along the route proposed therein, has been filed in my office.

Now Therefore, Notice is hereby given of the pendency of said petition, and that the same will be heard and considered by and before the board of county commissioners at their special session to be held at the court house in the city of Anoka in said county on the 10th day of December 1906 at 11 o'clock A. M. A true copy of said petition is as follows, to-wit:

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota. The undersigned land owners whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a public ditch along the following described route in the town of Centerville in said county of Anoka; that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit: That large quantities of land along the course of the proposed ditch are now wet, overflowed and rendered useless and of small value for farming purposes, which by the establishment and construction of the proposed ditch would be drained and rendered useful and of great value for farming purposes and others.

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and termini of said ditch is as follows: Commencing at a point on the east line of the east one-half of the southwest quarter of section No. 24 in township No. 31 and range 22 where Clearwater Creek so-called, crosses said line; thence running along the following route: following Clearwater or Creek westerly, crossing part of said section 24 and part of section 25; all of town No. 31, range 22, and terminating at a point in said section 25; township thirty-one range twenty-two, where the Centerville and Hugo road so-called, crosses said Clearwater Creek, on the south line of the north half of the northwest quarter of said section twenty-three, township thirty-one, range twenty-two, in said Clearwater Creek as its outlet with such branch or branches as may be necessary and proper to render such ditch most effectual.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such public ditch and cause the same to be constructed as provided by chapter two hundred and thirty (230) of the General Laws of Minnesota.

John Palmer the sheriff
being first duly sworn, says: That he now is, and for the past seventy years last past has been, a resident of the town of Centerville, in said County; that at the request of the County Auditor of said County, on the 14th day of November 1906, he posted a printed copy of the notice hereto attached in each of three of the most public places in the Township of Centerville to-wit:

One at The S.E. corner of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 24 one at The E. corner of the S.W. 1/4 of Sec. 29 and one at On the Town of Stone mill village; that on the day of Nov 14 1906, he posted a printed copy of said notice in each of three of the most public places in the Township of Centerville to-wit: One copy at Centerville and one at Centerville; that on the day of Nov 14 1906, he posted a copy of said notice in each of three of the most public places in the Township of Centerville to-wit: One copy at Centerville and one at Centerville; that the above named places are the duly designated and usual places for posting public notices in each of said Townships.

That on the 15th day of November 1906, he posted a copy of said notice on the door of the Court House at Carver in said County.
