AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING ON Viewers' Report in Ditch Proceedings.
State of Minnesota, County of Anoka—ss.
In the matter of the petition of J. W. Merrill and others for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning at a point on the south line of the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24, which point is east 135 feet from the sixteenth corner in the center of the ne¹/₄ of said section, and running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: ne¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, nw¹/₄ of ne¹/₄ of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24; sw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, lot 2, lot 6 and nw¹/₄ of nw¹/₄ of Sec. 25, T. 33, R. 24, ne¹/₄ of ne¹/₄ of Sec. 26 and se¹/₄ of se¹/₄ of Sec. 23, T. 33, R. 24, and terminating in Cedar creek in the se¹/₄ of the se¹/₄ of Sec. 23, T. 33, R. 24. Description of the Lee route from station 0 to station 40 is the same as for the main ditch. D. 1908, at ten o'clock a. m. at the auditor's office in the city of Anoka in said county for hearing and considering the petition, the said engineer's and said viewers' reports thereon; and that all persons interested in the construction of said ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said board of county commissioners at said time for or against the construction of said ditch.
