AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING ON Viewers' Report in Ditch Proceedings.

State of Minnesota, County of Anoka—ss. In the matter of the petition of J. W. Merrill and others for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning at a point on the south line of the ne 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24, which point is east 135 feet from the sixteenth corner in the center of the ne 1/4 of said section, and running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: ne 1/4 of ne 1/4, nw 1/4 of ne 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24; sw 1/4 of se 1/4, lot 2, lot 6 and nw 1/4 of nw 1/4 of Sec. 25, T. 33, R. 24, ne 1/4 of ne 1/4 of Sec. 26 and se 1/4 of se 1/4 of Sec. 23, T. 33, R. 24, and terminating in Cedar creek in the se 1/4 of the se 1/4 of Sec. 23, T. 33, R. 24. Description of the Lee route from station 0 to station 40 is the same as for the main ditch. Commencing at a point in Swan lake so-called, which point is north 31 degrees east 1000 feet from section corner 25, 26, 35, 36, T. 33, R. 24, and running thence in lot 1, Sec. 25, T. 33, R. 24, the nw 1/4 of nw 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24, the ne 1/4 of ne 1/4, nw 1/4 of ne 1/4, sw 1/4 of ne 1/4, ne 1/4 of nw 1/4, se 1/4 of nw 1/4, nw 1/4 of nw 1/4, Sec. 35, T. 33, R. 24; se 1/4 of ne 1/4, ne 1/4 of ne 1/4, nw 1/4 of ne 1/4, Sec. 34, T. 33, R. 24, and ending in the ne 1/4 of the nw 1/4, Sec. 34, T. 33, R. 24 in Cedar creek so-called.

Branch No. 2—Commencing at a point in the sw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of Sec. 36, T. 33, R. 24, 308 feet south 21 degrees west from station 11 plus 42 of the main line, running through sw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 and the nw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of said Sec. 36 and ending at station 11 plus 42 of the main line.
