The sale of ditching job on ditch No. 48 of Anoka County  
was opened at the auditor's office in the city of Anoka on the 3rd  
day of September, 1908, at 10:30 o'clock in the forenoon. There  
was but one bidder present and after some discussion the sale was  
adjourned to 2 o'clock P. M. At 2 o'clock P. M. the sale was re-  
opened and Albert Peterson bid 13c. per cubic yard for Stations 53  
to 124 plus 76 inclusive of the main ditch. This was the only bid  
received, and as the bidder did not put up the forfeiture called  
for, desiring first to revisit the ditch with the object of bidding  
on the whole ditch, the sale was adjourned to Tuesday, Sept. 8th,  
at 8 o'clock A. M.

At 8 o'clock A. M. Sept. 8th the auditor reopened the sale  
and Wm. F. Miller bid the sum of 13c. per cubic yard for the entire  
job. This was the only bid received and the ditch was sold to  
him, his bond being fixed at the sum of \$2655.
