The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden M. C. Blanchett, and others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch along the following described route:

Commencing at the lowest point in the N 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 33, Range 25 West of the 4th & P. M. in the said town of Barrow in the County of Anoka, and running thence, northwily in the said section 18 and easterly in sections 6 & 16 and connecting with the natural drain in said section 16, & thence in a curve to the N. E. corner of section 16, & thence in the town of Barrow in the County of Anoka

Now, if the said M. C. Blanchett & said Fred Kluge

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County and the Court in case of appeal according to law, shall fail to establish said ditch in the County then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
