AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING.
State of Minnesota, County of Anoka—ss.
In the matter of the petition of M. C. Blanchett and others for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota,
Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said Anoka county, Minnesota, praying for the construction of a public ditch, running through the following lands and described as follows:
Main ditch: Commencing at a point in the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of section 19, T. 33, R. 25, which point is station No. 0 of the main ditch No. 49 of Anoka county and is south 49 degrees east, three hundred and thirty (330) feet from the northwest corner of the said ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of Sec. 19, and thence the ditch runs northerly through the e¹/₂ of the se¹/₄, and the se¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of section 18 in said town and range; and thence runs northeasterly through the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of section 18 and the nw¹/₄ of the nw¹/₄ of section 17, and into the sw¹/₄ of the sw¹/₄ of section 8 and thence runs easterly leaving the sw¹/₄ of the sw¹/₄ of section 8, and through the se¹/₄ of the sw¹/₄, and in the sw¹/₄ of the se¹/₄ of section 8 to the south line of said section 8 to a point eight hundred and seventy-seven (877) feet east of the ¹/₄ corner in the south line of said section 8; and runs thence east on the section line between sections 8 and 17 to a point two hundred and thirty-seven (237) feet west of the southeast corner of said section 8; and runs thence southeasterly through the northeast corner of the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of section 17 and into the northeast corner of the sw¹/₄ of the nw¹/₄ of said section 18; and runs thence northerly and easterly through the ne¹/₄ of the nw¹/₄ of section 18 and ends in the Goose lake (so-called) in the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of section 18, all in the township number 33, range number 25.
Branch No. 1: Commencing at a point for station 0 of branch No. 1 which point is three hundred and ninety-six (396) feet west of the one-sixteenth (1-16) corner at the center of the se¹/₄ of Sec. 5, T. 33, R. 25, and running thence southeasterly through the northeast corner of the e¹/₂ of the sw¹/₄ of se¹/₄ of said section 5 and southerly through the se¹/₄ of the se¹/₄ of said section 5, and the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄, and the e¹/₂ of the ne¹/₄, and the w¹/₂ of the se¹/₄, all in section 8, and intersecting the main ditch at station 92 plus 29 in the southerly end of the sw¹/₄ of the se¹/₄ of said section 8 and there ending. All in T. 33, R. 25.
Branch No. 2: Commencing at a point for station 0 of branch No. 2, twenty (20) feet north of the one-sixteenth (1-16) corner in the center of the nw¹/₄ of Sec. 7, T. 33, R. 25, and thence running south on the north and south center line of said nw¹/₄ of section 7 to station 2 plus 44, and thence in a southeasterly direction through the se¹/₄ of nw¹/₄, the ne¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ and the se¹/₄ of nw¹/₄, all in said section 7, to a point on the north and south center line of said section 7 five hundred and forty-five (545) feet north of the quarter corner on the south side of said section 7 and thence south to the said quarter corner on the south side of section 7; and thence east on the section line between sections 7 and 18 to the southeast corner of the said section 7, and thence east on the section line between sections 8 and 17 to the main ditch five hundred and six (506) feet east of the said section corner, and there ending at station 60 plus 90 of the main ditch, all in T. 33, R. 25.
Branch No. 3: Commencing at a point for station 0 of branch No. 3 nine (9) feet west of the one-sixteenth (1-16) corner in the center of the sw¹/₄ of Sec. 7, T. 33, R. 25, and running thence east to station 1 plus 12, and running thence southerly through the se¹/₄ of the sw¹/₄ of said section 7 and into the north end of the ne¹/₄ of the nw¹/₄ of section 18 of the same town and range, and thence northeasterly to the quarter corner on the south side of section 7, T. 33, R. 25, and there ending, and connecting with branch No. 2, at station 42 plus 02 of said branch No. 2. All in T. 33, R. 25.
Branch No. 4: Commencing at a point for station 0 for branch No. 4, two hundred (200) feet east of section corner 5, 6, 7 and 8 of T. 33, R. 25; and thence running west on the section line four hundred and twenty-five (425) feet to a point on the north line of the ne¹/₄ of the ne¹/₄ of Sec. 7, T. 33, R. 25; and thence running southerly through the said ne¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, and the se¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, and the ne¹/₄ of the se¹/₄, all in section 7, to the southeast corner of the ne¹/₄ of the se¹/₄ of said section 7; and thence east on the east and west center line of the sw¹/₄ of section 8 to a point one hundred and fifty-two (152) feet west of the one-sixteenth (1-16) corner in the center of the sw¹/₄ of section 8; and thence south, three
