AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING.

State of Minnesota, County of Anoka—ss.  
In the matter of the petition of M. E. Beanebeck and others for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, state of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of the county of Anoka, Minnesota, praying for the construction of a public ditch, running through the following lands and described as follows:

Main ditch: Commencing at a point in the ne 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of section 19, T. 53, R. 25, which point is station No. 1 of the main ditch No. 49 of Anoka county and is south 49 degrees east three hundred and thirty (330) feet from the northeast corner of the said ne 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of Sec. 19, and thence the ditch runs northerly through the e 1/2 of the se 1/4, and the se 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of section 18 in said town and range; and thence runs northerly through the ne 1/4 of section 17, and easterly through the ne 1/4 of section 15 and thence into the sw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of section 11, and runs easterly leaving the se 1/4 of the sw 1/4 of section 8, and through the se 1/4 of the sw 1/4, and in the sw 1/4 of the se 1/4 of section 5 to the south line of said section 8 to a point eight hundred and seventy-seven (877) feet east of the 1/2 corner on the south line of said section 8; and runs thence east on the section line between sections 8 and 17 to a point two hundred and thirty-seven (237) feet west of the southeast corner of said section 8, and runs thence southeasterly through the northeast corner of the ne 1/4 of section 17, and through the nw 1/4 of the nw 1/4 of section 16 and into the northeast corner of the sw 1/4 of the nw 1/4 of said section 16; and runs thence northerly and easterly through the ne 1/4 of the nw 1/4 of section 16 and the nw 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of section 16 and ends in the Goose Lake (so-called) in the ne 1/4 of the ne 1/4 of section 16, all in the township number 53, range number 25, Branch No. 1.
