TO hereas, At a session of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of
Anoka State of Minnesota, held March 4 th
1889, a petition signed by John Olsen James M. Kelser, Reuben Suy P. Johnson John
Miller & rekson, Hous Hauson, Muly, Frank Hont P Peterson Charles Peterson Martha of H. M. Kienner and A. Limonson land owners, whose lands were liable to be affected by, or assessed for, the expense of the construc-
