Notice is Hereby Given That a petition has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County, praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning ~~at~~ near the center of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25,

running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, all of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25; also Branch No. 1, commencing at a point 50 ft. west of Sec. corner to Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, T. 33, R. 25, and running thence east on section line to a point 250 ft. east of said section corner and thence northeasterly to Station 0 of said main ditch near the center of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 14, of said township; the said main ditch terminating in Ford Brook in the ^{center of} said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25.
