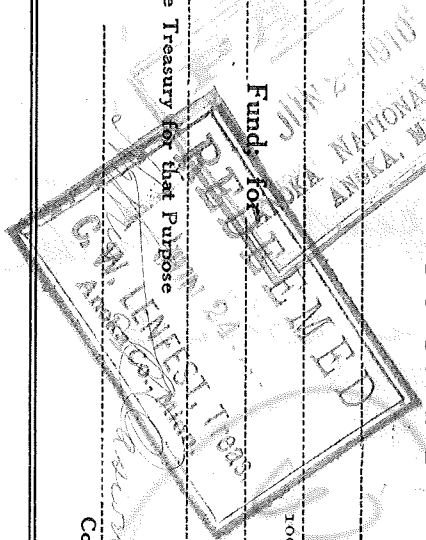

Affidavit of Extra Work on Ditch No. 50

To The Honorable Board of County Commissioners
Of Anoka County, Minnesota.

Gentlemen;-


I hereby certify that Mr. Jacob Kohler the contractor on Ditch No 50 did perform extra work on said Ditch to the Amount of Nineteen Dollars.

In the Construction of this ditch it was found that the soil near the outlirt of the old lake was vert loose material and was continually falling into the ditch at the said outlet and causing the ditch to fill, in accordance with the law on the ditches of this sState I did order the contractor Mr. Jacob kohler to lay Twenty Feet of Pipe over and above his contract on the said ditch amounting to some Sixteen Dollars (\$ 16.00)

In the original contract the estimate was made on the figures and the fact was overlooked that one of the stations fell in a small ditch thus giving less excavation than was actually on the ground and the engineer ordered the pipe to be placed properly with the understanding that the error would be rectified,

The extra excavation amounted to Three Dollars

Three is now due the said Jacob Kohler the sum of Nineteen Dollars in addition to his original contract and that he has performed work in sufficiedt quantity to entitle him to the said amounr.
