



# PETITION FOR PUBLIC DITCH.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka  
State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands will be liable to be affected by, or assessed for the expense of, the construction of the public ditch hereinafter described, would respectfully represent that the public health, convenience and welfare require the establishment and construction of a public ditch along the following described route in the Town of Burns in said County of Anoka

that the construction of the same would be of public benefit and utility, and is necessary for the the following reasons, to-wit: that it would drain and render tillable a large quantity of land which is now wet, unflowed and of no use for any purpose; that it would remove large quantities of stagnant water which are now a menace to the public health

A general description of the proposed starting point, route and terminus of said ditch is as follows:

Commencing at the lowest point in the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section Fourteen (14), in Township Thirty Three (33) and Range Twenty Five (25), and

thence running along the following route: from said point, via northwesterly direction across the north half of the southwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter, of said section fourteen, to Ford Brook

and terminating at said Ford Brook

as its outlet, with such branch or branches as may be advantageous and under said ditch of the greatest benefit
