as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto the County of Anoka State of Minnesota,

in the sum of Two hundred and fifty DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents.

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden John Iverson Jr., H. E. Shannon, and others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch and branches

along the following described route: Commencing at the lowest point in the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Fourteen (14) in Township Thirty Three (33) and Range Twenty Five (25), in Anoka County, Minnesota and running from said point in a northeasterly direction across the north half of the Southwest quarter, the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the northeast quarter of said section fourteen to Red Brook, and terminating in said Red Brook, as its outlet, with such branch or branches as may be advantageous and under said ditch of the greatest benefit

Now, if the said John Iverson Jr., H. E. Shannon, N. H. Scholbrook or John Iverson Sr.

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County, or the Court in case an appeal be taken from any order of said Board refusing to establish such ditch, shall fail to establish said proposed ditch and branches then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
