 In the matter of the petition of T. H. Scholbrook and others, for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning near the center of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 14, N. 33, R. 25, running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, all of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25; also Branch No. 1, commencing at a point 50 ft. west of Sec. corner to Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, T. 33, R. 25, and running thence east on section line to a point 250 ft. east of said section corner and thence northeasterly to station 0 of said main ditch near the center of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 14, of said township; the said main ditch terminating in Ford Brook in the center of said SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25, and that the names of the owners of the lands that will be affected by the construction of said ditch are as follows, to-wit: Elias Loberg, Andrew O.
