AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING ON Viewers' Report in Ditch Proceedings.

State of Minnesota, County of Anoka, ss.
In the matter of the petition of T. H. Scholbrook and others, for a public ditch in the county of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch beginning near the center of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 14, N. 33, R. 25, running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, SW 1/4 of SE 1/4 and SE 1/4 of SE 1/4, all of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25; also Branch No. 1, commencing at a point 50 ft. west of Sec. corner to Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, T. 33, R. 25, and running thence east on section line to a point 250 ft. east of said section corner and thence northeasterly to station 0 of said main ditch near the center of SW 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 14, of said township; the said main ditch terminating in Ford Brook in the center of said SE 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Sec. 14, T. 33, R. 25, and that the names of the owners of the lands that will be affected by the construction of said ditch are as follows, to-wit: Elias Loberg, Andrew O. Hovind, T. H. Scholbrook, Eric Mattson, Alfred Johnson, Franklin Benner, John Iverson, Jr., John Iverson, Sr., State Bank of Anoka, D. Shannon, D. E. Shannon, and the Town of Burns; and that the engineer appointed by the board of county commissioners of said county to make a survey of the route of said ditch has completed his work and made due report thereon and filed the same in the office of said county auditor; and that the viewers appointed by said board of county commissioners to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereon in the office of said county auditor.
