In the matter of the petition of F. A. Clark and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said Anoka County, Minnesota praying for the construction of a public ditch running through the following lands and described as follows:

Main Line- Commencing on the west line of Township No. 52 North, Range 25 West; of the 4th Principal Meridian, 4.75 chains south of the One-Fourth Section Corner on the west side of Section No. 7 of said township and range, and running thence southeasterly through the $\frac{5}{8}$ of said Section 7, which land is owned by C. N. Clark; easterly through the $\frac{8}{9}$ of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 7, owned by C. E. Branch No. 1- Commencing on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 owned by H. Chester and running thence south through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 owned by V. H. Houlton; and south through the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 and emptying into the main line of Ditch No. 51 at Station Eleven of that ditch on the lands owned by C. N. Clark;

Lateral One of Branch No. 1 of Ditch No. 51- Commencing on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 owned by C. N. Clark and running northeasterly through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 owned by Carrie Ferrin; and westerly into the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 7 and there emptying into Branch No. 1 at Station 19 of said branch.

Branch No. 2- Commencing on the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 51, Township 33 North, Range 25 west of the Fourth Principal Meridian owned by Adam Schimbeno and thence running southerly through the said forty acre tract and crossing the township line 330 feet east of the quarter corner on the north side of Sec. 6, Township 32, Range 25 west of the Fourth Principal Meridian, and thence south on the east line of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 6 between the lands owned by E. A. Chamberlain and Adam Schimbeno to the south line of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 6 and thence east on the south line of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ about 800 feet between the lands owned by Adam Schimbeno and W. J. Adams, and thence southwesterly through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 6 owned by W. J. Adams, and thence southeasterly through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 5, Township 32 North, Range 25 west of the fourth principal meridian owned by F. A. Masters, and thence southerly through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 5 owned by

A. Arrell, and thence southerly through the $\frac{1}{2}$ of Sec. 5 of said land owned by Fred Saunders to the east line of said eight acre tract, and thence south between the $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{2}$ of $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 5 between lands owned by Fred Saunders and H. Peterson to the south quarter post of said Sec. 5, and thence south on the line between the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, owned by H. R. Frederick, and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8 of said township and range owned by W. H. Houlton some 500 feet, and thence southeasterly across the said W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 8 owned by W. H. Houlton, and thence southeasterly and southerly through the SW corner of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 8 owned by Alice Perkins, and thence southerly through the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 8 owned by Geo. Peterson, and thence southeasterly on the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Sec. 5 on land owned by A. Arrell and there emptying into the Branch No. 2 of Ditch No. 51.—

And that the engineer appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County to make a survey of the route of said ditch has completed his work and made due report thereon and filed the same in the office of said county auditor; and that the viewers appointed by said Board of County Commissioners to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereon in the office of said county auditor.
