The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas Henry H. Schramm
and others

have filed a petition with County Auditor of Anoka County, State of
Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch
along the following described route

Commencing at a point on the west line of Section 7 of the town
of Ramsey, T. 32, R. 25 where the said west line crosses Trott Brook
(so-called) and thence following said brook and running easterly
through the said section 7, into the north part of section 18 of
said township and through sections eight (8) and nine (9) of the
said town of Ramsey T. 32, R. 25 and terminating at a point
in the said Trott Brook on the east line of section nine (9) of the
Township of Ramsey T. 32, R. 25, where the said east line of
section nine (9) crosses said Trott Brook, using the said Trott
Brook as its outlet.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to esta-
blish such proposed ditch and the necessary branches, and especially
a branch commencing at 1/4 section Cor. S. side, Sec. 5, T. 32, R. 25,
and running thence to Trott Brook, and cause the same to be construct
ed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Thirteen (213)

(so-called) and thence following said brook and running easterly through the said section 7, into the north part of section 18 of said township and through sections eight (8) and nine (9) of the said town of Ramsey T. 32, R. 25 and terminating at a point in the said Trott Brook on the east line of section nine (9) of the Township of Ramsey T. 32, R. 25, where the said east line of section nine (9) crosses said Trott Brook, using the said Trott Brook as its outlet.

And your petitioners pray that you will proceed to establish such proposed ditch and the necessary branches, and especially a branch commencing at $\frac{1}{4}$ section Cor. S. side, Sec. 5, T. 32, R. 25, and running thence to Trott Brook, and cause the same to be constructed as provided by Chapter Two Hundred and Thirty (230) of the General Laws of 1905 and Laws amendatory thereof.

and a Civil Engineer has been appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, to survey the same, and said engineer has filed his report thereon; and also viewers have been appointed who have reported thereon, and the Board of County Commissioners of said County have by their order bearing date the 5th day of January A. D. 1900, located and established the said tract according to the report of said engineer and said viewers, and the above bounden W. H. Howden

appeal S to the District Court aforesaid from the action of said Board of County Commissioners thereon.

Now, If the said W. H. Howden

shall duly prosecute such appeal, and shall pay all costs and expenses that may be adjudged against him and abide the order of said Court if the action of said Board of County Commissioners shall be sustained by the District Court aforesaid, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
