In the matter of the petition of F. A. Clark and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

WHEREAS, A petition has been filed bearing date the 14th day of January, 1909, praying for the establishment of a public ditch in said County along the route described in said petition, together with a proper bond accompanying the same, and said petition has been heard and considered by the Board of County Commissioners of said county at their meeting held on the 1st day of March, 1909, pursuant to notice of said hearing duly published and posted as by law required, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed a competent civil engineer, to-wit, J. E. Hill, to make a complete survey of said ditch and of the route thereof, who has on the 26th day of November, 1909, filed his report of said survey in my office, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed Wallace Patch, John Hunter and John Iverson to be viewers of said proposed ditch by their order filed in my office the 1st day of March, 1909.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED That said viewers be and meet at the auditor's office in the City of Anoka in said County on Tuesday, the 30th day of November, 1909, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day, preparatory to assuming and commencing their duties as said viewers, said time being within fifteen days after the filing of the engineer's report of his survey in said matter.
