Fred A. Clark and others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of

Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch

along the following described route: Commencing at a point on the west line of

section 7, of the Town of Ramsey, T. 32 R. 25, where the said west

line crosses Trott Brook (so-called) and thence following said Brook and running easterly through the said section 7; into the north part of Section 18 of said township, and through sections Eight (8) and Nine (9) of the said Township, and terminating at a point in said Trott Brook on the east line of Section Nine (9) of the Township of Ramsey, T. 32, R. 25, where the said east line of Section Nine (9) crosses said Trott Brook, using the said Trott Brook as its outlet, with necessary branches, and especially a branch commencing at the 1/4-section corner on south side of sec. 5, Twp. 32, Rnge. 25, and running thence to Trott Brook

Now, if the said Fred A. Clark, Charles E. Bowers and H. H. Schwab

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County, or the Court in case an appeal be taken from any order of said Board refusing to establish such ditch, shall fail to establish said proposed public ditch then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
