NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN That a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said Anoka County, Minnesota, praying for the construction of a public ditch running through the following lands and described as follows:

Main Line—Commencing on the west line of Township No. 32 North, Range 25 West, of the 4th Principal Meridian, 4.75 chains south of the One-Fourth Section Corner on the west side of Sec. No. 7 of said township and range, and running thence southeasterly through the sw 1/4 of said Sec. 7, which land is owned by C. N. Clark; easterly through the sw 1/4 of the se 1/4 of said Sec. 7, owned by C. E. Bowers; and easterly through the w 1/2 of the w 1/2 of se 1/4 of se 1/4 of said Sec. 7 over the land owned by J. Collins estate; and easterly through the e 1/2 of the w 1/2 of se 1/4 of se 1/4 of said Sec. 7 owned by A.
