We, the viewers of ditch No. 51, to whom was referred the original report of said viewers, respectfully return herewith the report amended by omitting the assessment of \$500.00 damages which were awarded to the town of Ramsey for rebuilding bridges described in said report, on account of the construction of the said ditch, and by reducing the total estimated cost and expense of the construction of said public ditch and its laterals and branches, including the damages awarded therefor, to the sum of \$6161.67.
