In the matter of the petition of H. A. Tangent and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said Anoka county, Minnesota, praying for the construction of a public ditch running through the following lands and described as follows:

Main Line—Commencing at a point in the southwest quarter of the ne¼ of Section 15, Town 31, Range 34, which point is north 64½ degrees west 178.7 feet from the southeast corner of said sw¼ of ne¼, which land is owned by J. D. Wilhelm, thence southeasterly through the nw¼ of the se¼ and the ne¼ of se¼ owned by E. C. Swanson; thence southeasterly and easterly through the se¼ of the se¼, owned by Laura Tangent, all of Section 15, Town 31, Range 24; thence southeasterly through the nw¼ of nw¼ of Section 23, owned by Otto Tronson and others; thence southeasterly through the south half of the nw¼ of Section 23 owned by F. B. Lincoln, and ending in a small creek where said creek crosses the south line of the se¼ of nw¼ of Section 23, said town and range:

Branch No. 1—Commencing at a point in the se¼ of ne¼ of Section 22, Town 31, Range 24, which point is south 5 deg. 40 min. east 915.5 feet from a point 941 feet due west of the northeast corner the of se¼ of the ne¼ of Section 22, said town and range, which land is owned by Eleanor Stahler; thence north through the se¼ of ne¼ and through the ne¼ of ne¼ of said Section 22; owned by W. H. Barney, terminating in the main ditch at Station 23 plus 7:

Branch No. 2—Commencing at a point in the nw¼ of sw¼ of Section 14, Town 31, Range 24, which land is owned by Otto Tronson and others which point is south 4 deg. 30 min. east 643.5 feet from the northeast corner of the ne¼ of the se¼ of Section 15, thence southeasterly through the ne¼ of the se¼ owned by E. C. Swanson, and southerly through the se¼ of se¼, owned by Laura Tangent, all of Section 15, Town 31, Range 24 and terminating in the main ditch at Station 33 plus 60.

And that the engineer appointed by the board of county commissioners of said county to make a survey of the route of said ditch has completed his work and made due report thereon and filed same in the office of the said county auditor; and that the viewers appointed by said board of county commissioners to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereon in the office of the said county auditor, and

That therefore, the board of county commissioners of said Anoka county, State of Minnesota, will hold a special meeting on Wednesday, the 10th day of August, A. D. 1910, at 10:30 o'clock a. m. of said day for hearing and considering the said petition, said engineer's and viewers' reports thereon, and that all persons interested in the construction of said ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said board of county commissioners at said time for or against the construction of said ditch.
