This is to certify that I have examined the work on County Ditch
No. 53 in your county, which work was constructed by the Road Construction Co

I respectfully report that the ditch is partially completed as follows:-
*From Station # 123+00 to Station # 120+00 - Tile 300 lineal
feet at \$2.12 per lineal foot and
excavation from Station 126+70 to Station 120+00
making 1137 cubic yards at .099 per cu. yd.
All in main line of Ditch #53*

The excavation of said ditch is practically complete between said
stations. Excavation of *1137.00* cubic yards. The said contractor
has performed work on the above sections to the sum of *\$748.56* and
he is entitled to a payment of Seventy-five (75%) per-cent of the said
amount, or the sum of \$ *561.42* is now due the said contractor
from the ditch fund of said Anoka county, and that no loss will result to
the said County by the payment of this amount.

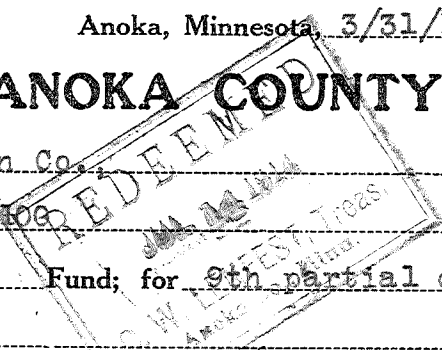
