
To The Honorable Commissioners,

Excavation 24,581.0 cubic yards. The said contractor has performed work on the above sections to the sum of ~~\$2450.72~~ ^{\$}2450.72 and he is entitled to a payment of Seventy-five (75) per cent of the said amount, or the sum of ~~\$1838.04~~ ^{\$}1838.04 is now due the said contractor from the Ditch fund of the said Anoka County, and that no loss will result to the said County by the payment of this amount.

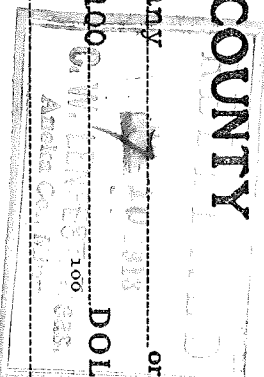
