Gentlemen:

We have examined specifications by James Corr, Engineer, and have likewise examined proposed work in connection with repair of County Ditch No. 53, and as a result of these examinations and determinations, we propose as follows:

We will furnish #12 U. S. Gauge Toncan (No-co-ro) metal, 99.90% pure iron, 24" diameter, full inside measurement Acme construction corrugated culvert pipe with joints cemented and calked with Gilsonite and other permanent calking material to make job absolutely water tight, and will furthermore provide ample expansion joints and sufficient air holes. We will furnish all material as above, tools and labor and supplies necessary to complete the job in a good and workmanlike manner satisfactory to the Engineer, including the replacing of 5 feet of dirt covering over the corrugated pipe above described, all for the sum of 4.50 per lineal foot.

(Four dollars and fifty cents per lineal foot)

We will clean the open ditch between the tile line and Golden Lake for the lump sum of \$1200.00.

When completed, we will leave the job in a clean and workmanlike manner.

As evidence of our good faith we enclose herewith our certified check for 750.00, which we agree to forfeit to said County of Anoka in case we do not enter into contract and furnish satisfactory bond within ten days after the acceptance of this bid.
