have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of
Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public Ditch

along the following described route: Commencing at or about the quarter stake
on the east line of section fourteen (14) & thence southerly
thro said section fourteen (14) & southerly thro section
Twenty three (23) & thence southeasterly thro sections
Twenty six (26) & Twenty five (25) until it reaches
Golden Lake & thence terminating all in the Town of Blaine
Kauka Co Minnesota & also all branches that may
be necessary, all in Township thirty one (31) of
range twenty three (23)
