Auditor's Notice of Pendency of Petition.

State of Minnesota, County of Anoka, ss.—  
Whereas the petition of E. L. Gilbert and others,  
bearing date the 31st day of March, 1910, a true  
copy of which follows below, praying for the  
establishment of a public ditch along the route  
proposed therein, has been filed in my office;  
now therefore, notice is hereby given of the  
pendency of said petition and that the same  
will be heard and considered by and before the  
Board of County Commissioners at their special  
session to be held at the auditor's office in the  
city of Anoka in said county on the 3rd day of  
May, 1910, at 10:30 o'clock a. m.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the  
County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

The undersigned land owners, whose lands  
will be liable to be affected by or assessed for  
the expense of the construction of the ditch  
hereinafter described, would respectfully rep-  
resent that the public health, convenience and  
welfare require the establishment and con-  
struction of a public ditch along the following  
described route in the town of Blaine in said  
county of Anoka; that the construction of the  
same would be of public benefit and utility and  
is necessary for the following reasons, to-wit:  
to drain large areas of land now flooded and  
useless and render the same usable and valuable;  
to drain off stagnant waters thereon which con-  
stitute menace to the public health.

A general description of the proposed starting  
point, route and terminus of said ditch is as  
follows: Commencing at or about the quarter  
stake on the east line of section 14 and thence  
southwesterly through said section 14 and  
southerly through section 23 and thence south-  
easterly through sections 26 and 25 until it  
reaches Golden Lake, and there terminating,  
all in said town of Blaine, Anoka County, Minn.,  
township 31 of range 23, and also all branches  
that may be necessary and terminating in said  
Golden Lake as its outlet.

And your petitioners pray that you will pro-  
ceed to establish such ditch and cause the same  
to be constructed as provided by chapter 290 of  
the general laws of Minnesota for 1905 and the  
laws amendatory thereof and supplementary  
thereto.
