Station zero (0) of Lateral No. 2 is located nine hundred eighty-eight (988) feet south and forty-nine and five tenths (49.5) feet west of the west quarter (w 1/4) corner of section eleven (11) in township thirty-one (31) n range twenty-three (23) w and running thence north parallel with the west line of said section eleven (11) to station nineteen plus eighty eight (19 plus 88) and there ending in branch ditch No. 2 at station forty-three plus twenty-four (43 plus 24) of said branch ditch No. 2. DEVINE LATERAL TO BRANCH DITCH NO. 2. Station zero (0) of Devine Lateral is located eleven hundred forty-five (1145) feet east and ten (10) feet south of the northwest (nw) corner of section eleven (11) in township thirty-one (31) n range twenty-three (23) w; thence s 2 deg. 45 min. e to station nine plus nineteen and five tenths (9 plus 19.5); thence s 29 deg. 5 min. e to station fourteen (14); thence s 89 deg. 25 min. e to station twenty-one (21) thence s 15 deg. 40 min. e to station twenty-four plus ninety (24 plus 90) then s 0 deg. 23 min. w to station thirty-four plus forty-six (34 plus 46) and there ending in branch ditch No. 2 at station sixty-six plus thirty-one (66 plus 31) of said branch ditch No. 2. D. 1911, at 10:30 o'clock a. m. at the auditor's office in the city of Anoka, for hearing and considering said petition, said engineer's viewers' reports thereon, and that all persons interested in the construction of said ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said board of county commissioners at the time for or against the construction of said ditch at Anoka, Minn., this 16th day of July, 1911.
