



SALE OF JOBS--DITCH 53.

November 11, 1911.

The sale of the job of constructing County Ditch No. 53 was opened at 10:30 a.m., but as several of the bidders had only arrived a few minutes before the time set time was allowed all bidders to inspect the engineer's report and profile and arrange their bids.

Bids were finally received at 11:15 as follows: Ex. per yd. Tile. Complete. E. Gilmore & Son, complete job. . . . Charles W. Rood Construction Co. . . \$30,065.00 9.97¢ Sta. \$212 26,905.24 27,500.00 Interstate Drainage Co., complete job . 10.49% 12% and \$2 per sta. for levelling. 11.50g \$2100 27.998.92

Charles W. Rood Construction Co. having presented the lowest bid the contract was awarded that company, work to be commenced April 15, 1912, and to be completed on or before December 31, 1912.

Engineer James Corr and Albert F. Pratt Esq., county attorney, were present and approved the sale made by the auditor.

At 1 p. m. the auditor, attorney and engineer met the representative of the Charles W. Rood Construction Company, of Grand Rapids, Wisc., and entered into a written contract with the firm,
