


AUDITOR'S ORDER FOR VIEWERS' MEETING.

In the matter of the Petition of H. N. Douglass and others for a Public Ditch  
in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota:

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed bearing date the 12th day of October, 1912,  
praying for the establishment of a public ditch in the Town of Anoka in said  
County, along the route described in said petition, together with a proper bond  
accompanying the same, and said petition has been heard and considered by the  
Board of County Commissioners of said County at its meeting held on the 10th  
day of June, 1914, pursuant to notice of said hearing duly published and post-  
ed as by law required, and the said board of County Commissioners has appointed  
a competent civil engineer, to-wit, Wayne L. Ridge, to make a complete survey of  
said ditch and of the route thereof, who has on the 24th day of November, 1914,  
filed his report of said survey in my office, and the said Board of County Com-  
missioners has appointed, John Iverson, Berger Titterud and Lyman H. Hoyt to be  
Viewers of said proposed ditch by their order filed in my office on the 10th day  
of June, 1914,

NOW, THEREFORE, It is hereby ordered that said viewers be and meet at the aud-  
itor's office in the city of Anoka, in said County on Saturday, the 28th day of  
November, 1914, at 10 o'clock A. M., preparatory to assuming and commencing their  
duties as said viewers, said time being within fifteen days after the filing of  
the Engineer's Report of his survey in said matter.
