The condition of this obligation is such, that whereas, the above bounden, Grace Bickford, has appealed to the District Court of the County of Anoka and State of Minnesota, from the action of the Board of County Commissioners of said Anoka County, assessing benefits to certain lands, in the Matter of the Petition of H. N. Douglass and others for a public Ditch in the said County of Anoka, said action having been taken on the 6th. day of January A. D. 1915.

Now Therefore, if the said Grace Bickford, shall duly prosecute the said appeal and pay all costs and disbursements that may be adjudged against her and abide the order of the Court herein, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
