TO ALL PERSONS INTERESTED IN COUNTY DITCH NO. 54, BRANCH NO. 3, IN ANOKA COUNTY:

VOU, AND EACH OF YOU, WILL PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that the State of Minnesota, by James C. Marshall, its Commissioner of Highways, has filed a Petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, pursuant to Section 161.28 of Minnesota Statutes 1959, praying that he be allowed to make a minor alteration or change in County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3, That attached to said Petition now on file with the County Auditor are plan and cross-section sheets marked Exhibit "A" and right of way map marked Exhibit "B", showing said minor alteration or change petitioned for That the portion of said County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3, as now located which is proposed to be changed or altered is described as follows:

Approximate Present Location of a Portion of County Ditch No., 54, Branch No. 3:

Beginning at a point in present County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3, distant 363 feet west and 252 feet south of the east quarter corner of section 9, township 31 north, range 24 west; thence run southwesterly to a point distant 672 feet west and 586 feet south of said quarter corner; thence run westerly to a point distant 1036 feet west and 647 feet south of said quarter corner, and there terminating.

Approximate Proposed Location of a Portion of County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3:

Beginning at a point in present County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3, distant 363 feet west and 252 feet south of the east quarter corner of section 9, township 31 north, range 24 west; thence run southwesterly to a point distant 628 feet west and 540 feet south of said quarter corner; thence continue southwesterly to a point in present County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3, distant 890 feet west and 615 feet south of said quarter corner and there terminating.

That said Petition alleges that it is advantageous and desirable in the construction and maintenance of Trunk Highway No. 10 that said minor alteration or change be made, and that said minor alteration or change petitioned for will not affect the functioning or impair the efficiency of said Anoka County Ditch No. 54, Branch No. 3.
