ORDER OF COUNTY BOARD

Re: Petition of the State of Minnesota  
by M. J. Hoffmann, its Commissioner of Highways,  
for the right to make minor alterations or  
changes in Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka  
County Ditch No. 54.

The above entitled matter came on for hearing before the County Board of Anoka County in the County Commissioners' room in the court house at Anoka, Minnesota, on the 7th day of April, 1952, at 11:00 o'clock a.m.

The petitioner appeared by Bert McMullen, Special Assistant Attorney General.

The petitioner presented evidence in support of its petition for permission to make a minor alteration or change in Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka County Ditch No. 54, all as shown in the plans attached to the petition.

It was made to appear that the minor alteration or change in said Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka County Ditch No. 54 petitioned for by the petitioner would be advantageous or desirable in the maintenance and construction of Trunk Highway No. 242.

It was further made to appear that said minor alteration or change in said Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka County Ditch No. 54 would in no way affect or impair the efficiency of the drainage system.

The County Board, having heard the evidence adduced by the petitioner in support of its petition for permission to make a minor alteration or change in Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka County Ditch No. 54, all as shown on the plans attached to said petition marked Exhibit "A" and made a part thereof by reference, hereby makes its order consenting to and granting permission to said petitioner to make the minor alteration or change in Branch 1 and Branch 5 of Anoka County Ditch No. 54, all as shown in the plans attached to said petition marked Exhibit "A" and made a part thereof by reference.

The Board further orders that the petitioner, State of Minnesota by

M. J. Hoffmann, Commissioner of Highways, pay the sum of \$ 10.80  
to the County of Anoka for publication and filing fees incurred by said  
County in this matter.

It is further ordered by the Board that damages if any for any  
additional lands necessary for said change or alteration shall be paid  
by the petitioner herein.
