DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators firmly by these presents.

one thousand nine hundred and twelve (1912).

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden William M. Stockwell and others

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch and branches

along the following described route: commencing at the point where Coon Creek crosses the North line of Section Nine (9), in Township Thirty-one (31) and Range Twenty-four (24), thence following generally the course of Coon Creek, widening, deepening and cutting the bends of the same, southerly through said Section Nine (9), and Easterly through Section Ten (10), said Township and Range, and Southeasterly through the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Eleven (11), said Township and Range, and Southerly through the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Fourteen (14), said Township and Range, and terminating at the point where said Coon Creek crosses the East and West Quarter Section line of said Section Fourteen (14), in said Coon Creek as its out-let;

Now if the said William M. Stockwell

shall pay all expenses, in case the County Board of said County or the Court in case an appeal be taken from any order of said Board refusing to establish such public ditch, shall fail to establish said proposed public ditch, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
