STATE OF MINNESOTA, COUNTY OF ANOKA, ss.

In the matter of the petition of Gust Lundahl and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given, that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch, the route of which is described as follows:
Main Ditch.—Commencing at a point 430 feet north of the northeast corner of Government lot 7, section 15, township 33 range 23, thence southeasterly through said section 15 and sections 23 and 26 to its outlet in Coon Lake in section 26, all in township 33, range 23.

Branch No. 1.—Commencing at a point in the $se\frac{1}{4}$ of $ne\frac{1}{4}$ of section 22, township 33, range 23, thence southeasterly through section 22 and section 27 and into section 26, to its outlet in the main ditch in the $nw\frac{1}{4}$ of $se\frac{1}{4}$ of section 26, all in township 33, range 23.

And that the engineer appointed by the board of county commissioners of said county to make a survey of the route of said ditch has completed his work and made due report thereon and filed the same in the office of said county auditor; and that the viewers appointed by said board of county commissioners to view the same have completed their work and filed their report thereon in the office of said county auditor.

And that, therefore, the Board of County Commissioners of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, will hold a special meeting at the auditors office in the court house in the city of Anoka, on Wednesday, the 14th day of June, 1916, at 10:30 o'clock a. m., for hearing and considering said petition and of the engineers' and viewers' reports thereon; and that all persons interested in the construction of said ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said board of county commissioners at said time for or against the construction of said ditch.
