

In the Matter of the Petition of Gust Lundahl and others for a Public Ditch in the
County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed bearing date the 19th day of July, 1915, praying for the establishment of a public ditch in said county along the route described in said petition, together with a proper bond accompanying the same, and said petition has been heard and considered by the Board of County Commissioners of said County at its meeting held on the 7th day of October, 1915, pursuant to notice of said hearing duly given, published and posted, as by law required, and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed a competent civil engineer, to-wit: Wayne L. Ridge, to make a complete survey of said ditch and of the route thereof, who has on the 1st day of April, 1916, filed his report thereof in my office and the said Board of County Commissioners has appointed G. W. Wyatt and Adam Schimbeno and Harry Edmunds to be viewers of said proposed ditch by its order~~now~~ filed in my office on the 7th day of October, 1915,

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that said viewers be and meet at the auditor's office in the City of Anoka, in said county, on Wednesday, the 12th day of April, 1916, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of said day, preparatory to assuming and commencing their duties as said viewers, said time being within fifteen days after the filing of the engineer's report of his survey in said matter.
