That Charles Anderson, Ed Nordquist and Gust Lundahl

are held and firmly bound unto the County of Anoka State of Minnesota, in the sum of One Thousand

DOLLARS, lawful money of the United States of America, to be paid to the said County of Anoka

State of Minnesota, its successors or assigns, for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents.

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such, That whereas the above bounden Charles Anderson, Ed Nordquist and Gust Lundahl

have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch

along the following described route: Commencing at a point

where the public highway now crosses the North line of the South half of the South East quarter (N line of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of S E $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen, Township Thirty-three, Range Twenty-three, County of Anoka, running thence in a southeasterly direction through Sections Fifteen, Fourteen, Twenty-three, and Twenty-six all in Township Thirty-three, Range Twenty-three of said County, to a point where the east line of section Twenty-six meets the shore of Coon Lake, and there terminating and having as its outlet the said Coon Lake, together with such branches, extensions and laterals as may be necessary properly to drain said lands.

Now, if the said Charles Anderson, Ed Nordquist and Gust Lundahl

shall pay all expenses, in case the Board of County Commissioners of said County and the Court in case of appeal according to law, shall fail to establish said Ditch

then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
