In the matter of the petition of N. Thompson and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.

Notice is hereby given that a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch, the route of which is described as follows:

Main Ditch—Commencing at a point in the nw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 30, Twp. 32, R. 23, which point is south 78¹/₂ degrees east, 800 feet from the center of said section 30, thence in a southwesterly direction through said Sec. 30, thence westerly through the south half of Sec. 25, Twp. 32, R. 24, thence south and west through Sec. 26 and part of Sec. 35, thence northwesterly through Sec. 27, thence southwesterly through Sec. 28, thence southerly through Sec. 33, all in Twp. 32, R. 24, thence southerly through Sec. 4, Twp. 31, R. 24, to its outlet in county ditch No. 54 on the south line of Sec. 4, Twp. 31, R. 24.

Branch No. 1—Commencing 350 feet west of the east 1-16 corner of the se¹/₄ of Sec. 25, Twp. 32, R. 24, thence south 43 degrees east to the east line of said Sec. 25, thence south 26 degrees east 350 feet to the end in the sw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ of Sec. 30, Twp. 32, R. 23.

The viewers recommend that branches be established and constructed as follows:

Branch No. 2—Commencing at a point 33 feet east and 1500 feet north of the south ¹/₄ corner of Sec. 20, Twp. 32, R. 23, thence southwesterly through said Sec. 20 and southwesterly across the nw¹/₄ of Sec. 29 and southwesterly into Sec. 30, all in Twp. 32, R. 23, to its outlet at the place of beginning of the main ditch.

Branch No. 3—Commencing at a point 180 feet north of the center 1-16 corner of the nw¹/₄ of Sec. 32, Twp. 32, R. 23, thence westerly through the nw¹/₄ of nw¹/₄ of said section, thence northwesterly across the ne¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, of Sec. 31, thence northwesterly across the s¹/₂ of se¹/₄, Sec. 30, all of said town and range, to its outlet in the main ditch.

Branch No. 4—Commencing at the ne corner of the s¹/₂ of sw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 29, thence southeasterly through se¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 29, all of Twp. 32, R. 24, thence westerly to its outlet in the main ditch in the sw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ of Sec. 28, Twp. 32, R. 24.

Branch No. 5—Commencing at a point north 35¹/₂ degrees west 1100 feet from the se corner of Sec. 23, thence westerly and southerly through

the se¹/₄ and the e¹/₂ of sw¹/₄ of Sec. 23, and southerly to its outlet in the main ditch in the ne¹/₄ of nw¹/₄ of Sec. 33, all in Twp. 32, R. 24, together with two laterals in said Sec. 23.

R. P. CHASE being duly sworn, on oath says: That he knows of his own knowledge that the annexed printed Final Hearing, Ditch No. 57

hereto attached, was taken from the columns of the newspaper known as THE ANOKA HERALD, and was published in said newspaper for 3 successive weeks, first on Tuesday, the 18th day of July, 1916, and thereafter on each successive Tuesday until and including Tuesday, the 10th day of August, 1916. That during the whole time of said publication affiant was the ^{President} secretary of the Anoka Herald Publishing Company, which was during said time, and still is, a corporation under the Laws of the State of Minnesota, and the proprietor, printer and publisher of said newspaper. That for more than one year prior to the commencement of said publication therein, said newspaper has been, and still is, a weekly newspaper, issued, printed and published on Tuesday of each week, in the English language, in column and sheet form, equivalent in space to more than four pages with five columns of at least seventeen and three-quarters inches length to each page, from a known office, established in such place of publication, equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same, and located and printed in the City of Anoka, County of Anoka and State of Minnesota, from whence it purported to be, was and is, issued; and that during all said time it contained, and still contains, general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, and that during all said time it has been, and still is, circulated in and near its place of issue and publication to the extent of more than two hundred and forty copies, regularly delivered to paying subscribers. That on the Ninth day of August, 1911, the affidavit of R. P. Chase, Secretary of said corporation, publisher of said newspaper, was filed in the office of the County Auditor of said Anoka County, for the purpose of complying with Section 5516 of the Revised Laws, 1905.
