AUDITOR'S NOTICE OF HEARING ON PETITION AND ENGINEER'S AND VIEWERS' REPORTS STATE OF MINNESOTA County of Anoka, ss.

In the Matter of the Petition of Ernest A. Michel and Others, for a Public Ditch in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, Designated and Numbered as County Ditch No. 57.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That a petition has been filed in the office of the County Auditor of said County, praying for the repair of a public ditch, designated and numbered by the County Auditor of such County as County Ditch No. 57 beginning at the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section thirty (30), Township thirty-two (32), Range twenty-three (23), running thence through the following described lands, to-wit: Sections nineteen (19) and thirty (30), Township thirty-two (32), Range twenty-three (23); Sections fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), twenty-two (22), twenty-three (23), twenty-one (21), twenty-five (25), twenty-six (26), twenty-seven (27), twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29), thirty-one (31), thirty-two (32), thirty-three (33), thirty-five (35), and thirty-six (36), Township thirty-two (32), Range twenty-four (24); Sections three (3) and four (4), Township thirty-one (31), Range twenty-four (24), and terminating at Southeast Quarter of Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section four (4), Township thirty-one (31), Range twenty-four (24) as appears by the report of the Engineer hereinafter mentioned and that the names of the owners of the lands and the names of the Municipal and other corporations that will be affected by the construction of said ditch, as appears in the report of the Viewers, hereinafter mentioned, are as follows, to-wit:

And that, therefore, the County Board of Anoka County, State of Minnesota, will hold a special meeting on Tuesday the 20th day of May 1947, at the County Auditor's office in the City of Anoka in said County, at 10 o'clock A.M., of said day, for hearing and consideration of said petition and of said Engineer's and viewer's report thereon; and that all persons interested in the construction of said ditch are invited to appear and be heard by and before said County Board at said time for or against the construction of said ditch.

C. A. CHASE, being duly sworn, on oath says; that she is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as The Anoka Herald, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Auditor's Notice of Hearing On Petition and Engineer's and Viewers' Reports, Ditch No. 57

hereinafter described, said newspaper was printed and published in the City of Anoka, in the County of Anoka, State of Minnesota, on Wednesday of each week; that during all said time said newspaper has been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the City of Anoka from which it purports to be issued as above stated and in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column, two inches wide; has been issued once each week from a known office established in said place of publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same; that the press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve has been done in its known office of publication; that during all said time in its makeup not less than twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community it purports to serve; that during all said time it has not wholly duplicated any other publication, and has not been entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements; has been circulated in and near its said place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty (240) copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has entry as second class matter in its local postoffice; and that there has been on file in the office of the County Auditor of Anoka County, Minnesota, the affidavit of a person having knowledge of the facts, showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of the conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper.

That the Auditor's Notice of Hearing On Petition and Engineer's and Viewers' Reports, Ditch No. 57

hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for 3 successive weeks; that it was first so published on Wednesday, the 16th day of April, 1947; and thereafter on Wednesday of each week to and including the 30th day of April, 1947; and that following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
