After due consideration and discussion by the Board, Commissioner Ward offered the following resolution and moved its adoption which motion was seconded by Commissioner Ramsden:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka, in view of and pursuant to the evidence produced by the land owners of lands drained by County Ditch No. 57 at the hearings held on the 11th day of July, 1946, May 20, 1947 and May 26, 1947 that the cleaning of said ditch is unnecessary to the adequate drainage of the lands affected and such cleaning would not be to the public interest.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted.

It was moved by Commissioner Ward and seconded by Commissioner Stack that the petition for the cleaning of County Ditch No. 57 be denied. Upon roll call vote, all voted "yes" and the resolution was declared adopted.
