COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS

Court House
Anoka, Minnesota
May 20, 1947

Meeting called to order at 10 o'clock A. M. with the following members present: Commissioners Broadbent, Peterson, Stack and Ward.

The purpose of this meeting was for hearing and consideration of the petition and of said engineer's and viewers' report in the matter of the petition of Ernest A. Michel and Others for the repair of Ditch No. 57.

After hearing all who wished to be heard, Commissioner Ward offered the following resolution and moved its adoption which motion was seconded by Commissioner Stack:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners in the County of Anoka at the hearing on the viewer's report on the cleaning of Ditch #57, in view of the following circumstances:

- (1) Whereas it has appeared from the evidence produced at the hearing that a large and substantial amount of cleaning has been done by private owners since the date of the petition, and
- (2) The large group of land owners present for this hearing were not present at the original hearing on the petition, at which those few then present caused it to appear that the said ditch required cleaning, and whereas now this large group of land owners have testified that their lands are adequately drained at the present time, and
- (3) Whereas it has appeared that several land owners affected failed to receive notices of the original hearing on the petition for cleaning, that

the petition for cleaning of Ditch #57 should be referred to the Engineer for reconsideration, the Engineer being instructed to report to this Board on Monday, May 26th, and all proceedings herein be stayed, pending a determination on that date as to whether or not said ditch requires cleaning.

The foregoing resolution was duly adopted.

It was moved by Commissioner Ramsden and seconded by Commissioner Peterson that the meeting adjourn to May 26, 1947 at 10 o'clock A. M. Motion carried.
