It was moved by Commissioner Ramsden and seconded by Commissioner Ward that the action taken by this Board on November 12th, 1945 whereby they appointed J. E. Hill as Engineer to examine Ditch No. 57 be rescinded because of the inability of Mr. Hill to serve. Motion carried.

The County Board hereby resolves that Ditch No. 57 is out of repair and the repair thereof is necessary if said ditch is to accomplish its purpose:

The Board further resolves that R. G. Streetley be appointed Engineer to examine the ditch and make the report of the necessary repairs with the estimated cost thereof and all details, plans and specifications required to supply the necessary details to enable the County Board to let a contract for the repair of said ditch.

The Board further resolves that the rate of pay be set at \$12.00 per day and work to be started as soon as practical. Motion carried.
