have filed a petition with the County Auditor of Anoka County, State
of Minnesota, praying for the establishment and construction of a public ditch

Commencing at a point

where Public Ditch Number Two joins the said Coon Creek, so called, in the north half of the southeast quarter of Section Thirty Township Thirty-two, Range Twenty-three, in said Anoka County, then proceeding in a westerly and southerly direction through the aforesaid section Thirty, following generally the course of Coon Creek; thence continuing in a westerly direction along the general course of said Coon Creek through Sections Twenty-five, Twenty-six, Twenty-seven, Twenty-eight, Twenty-nine, and Thirty-three of Township Thirty-two, Range Twenty-four, in said Anoka County, thence southerly, and along the general course of Coon Creek as aforesaid until the point is reached where Coon Creek meets the so-called Main Street Road, and there terminating, said point being in Section Four, Township Thirty-one, Range Twenty-four of said Anoka County, and having as its outlet said Coon Creek, together with such branches, extensions and laterals as may be necessary to drain said lands.
