And we further report that, at the completion of our work, as aforesaid, we did sum up the total estimated benefits of the construction of said Witch + Branch No. 1 and find, and hereby report, the same to be the sum of Twenty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty and 25/100 DOLLARS; and that we did sum up the total estimated cost and expense of the construction of said Witch + Branch No. 1 and find, and hereby report, the same to be the sum of Twenty-four Thousand Ninety and Fifty-eight and 5/100 DOLLARS, including the damages awarded therefor, and the increase of cost of Viewers report over estimate.

We further report that we have considered the relative utility and estimated expense of construction of said Witch and find, and hereby report, that the utility of the same is greater than the said estimated expense thereof, including said damages awarded.

We further report that the said proposed Witch will be of public utility; and that the construction of the same is practicable for the following reasons: To drain large areas of land now flooded and useless and render the same usable and valuable. To drain off stagnant waters thereon which now constitute a nuisance to the public health. Respectfully submitted,

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Anoka
 State of Minnesota:

The undersigned viewers, appointed by your order, bearing date the 26th of Oct and 26th
 day of Nov. A. D. 1915, to view the route proposed and set forth in the
 petition of N. Thompson and others, for a public ditch
 _____, respectfully report as follows, viz.:

That at the time and place specified in the order of the County Auditor of said County, to wit:
 at Anoka in the town of Anoka in said County, on
 the 29th day of May A. D. 1916, at 10 o'clock
 in the fore noon of said day, we did meet preparatory to commencing our duties as such
 viewers; and having each taken and subscribed the oath required by law to faithfully perform our
 duties, and having received from the County Auditor of said County, within five days after the filing
 of the engineer's report of his survey in the matter of said ditch,
 certified copies of the said petition for said ditch, of the order of
 your Honorable Board appointing us viewers, and of the order of said County Auditor designating
 the time and place for said first meeting of said viewers, we did, with Wayne L. Ridge
 _____, the said civil engineer, appointed by you to have charge of said
 matter, to wit:

view and examine the said proposed ditch from its source to its outlet,
 together with the branches thereof, the lands over which the same passes, the lands adjacent thereto
 to be affected thereby, and, as required by law and the requirements of your said order appointing
 us, ascertain the facts following, viz.: the names of the owners of each tract of land to be benefited
 and damaged by the construction of said proposed ditch; a description of
 each tract of land to be benefited and damaged thereby (said names of owners being the same as
 appears on the County tax duplicates of said County, and said descriptions being in legal form); the
 total number of acres in each of said tracts; the estimated number of acres in each of said tracts
 which will be benefited and damaged, as the case may be; the number of acres added to each of said
 tracts, if any, by the drainage of any meandered lake or change of course of any watercourse occa-
 sioned by the construction of said ditch; the description and location
 of all land added to any of said tracts by said drainage of any meandered lake and by the change
 of course of any watercourse; the value of all land so added to any of said tracts of land; the damage
 to the riparian rights of each of said tracts; the total estimated amount of benefits to each of said
 tracts of land, and the total estimated amount of damage or injury to each of said tracts of land;
 and did cause all the said facts, so ascertained by us, to be prepared and set forth in tabular form
 and statement, which said tabular statement is hereto attached and made a part hereof, designated
 "Exhibit 1."

And we did further ascertain, where the said proposed ditch runs
 along a public or corporate road or railroad, or drains, benefits, damages or affects such road or
 railroad, the facts following, viz.: the names of the owners of such roads and railroads; the names
 of such roads and railroads; a description of the parts of such roads and railroads drained, benefited,
 damaged and affected; a description of the nature of the benefits to the parts of said roads and
 railroads benefited; a description of the nature of the damages to the parts of such roads and rail-
 roads damaged; the estimated amount of benefits to each part of said roads and railroads so bene-
 fitted; and the estimated amount of damages and injury to each part of said roads and railroads so
 damaged or injured; and did further estimate and award the damages to each municipal and other
 corporation, persons, association of persons, telephone and telegraph companies for injury to all
 roads, road-beds, railroads, telephone and telegraph lines, owned by them, from the necessary con-
 struction and maintenance of all bridges, culverts and other works rendered necessary by the estab-
 lishment of said ditch, and have stated the same separately; which facts, last aforesaid, we did cause
 to be arranged and set forth in a tabular statement hereto attached and made a part hereof, desi-
 gnated "Exhibit 2."

We did further cause to be kept an accurate account of all our services and time while engaged in making said view and examination; the nature and kind of work done by us; the number of days each one of us was engaged in said work; the amount charged per day by each of us; every item of expense incurred by us in said work; and the total amount of all our expenses and compensation in said work; which account, last stated, we have caused to be set forth in tabular statement hereto attached and made a part hereof, designated "Exhibit 3."

In making our estimates of benefits to each said tracts of land by the construction of said Witch, wherever the same is located in whole or in part along the bed of a private ditch already constructed, we did deduct the amount of the reduction of the cost of the construction of the part of said Witch on each tract of land, as ascertained and set forth by said engineer in his report, from the estimate of benefits to each tract of land.

We further recommend that a branch ditch be established and constructed to be known as Branch No. 2 and described as follows: Commencing at a point 33 ft. East and 1500 ft. North of the $S\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Sec 20 Twp 32 R. 23, thence running West 100 ft. thence $S\ 29^{\circ}W$ 1200 ft. thence $S\ 11^{\circ}W$ 190 ft. thence $S\ 1\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 310 ft. thence $S\ 22^{\circ}W$ 181 ft. thence $S\ 70\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 619 ft. thence $S\ 75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 791 ft. thence $S\ 18^{\circ}W$ 474 ft. thence $S\ 27^{\circ}W$ 535 ft. thence $S\ 54\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 412 ft. thence $S\ 58^{\circ}W$ 1908 ft. to sta 0 of the main Witch and crossing the following described lands to wit: N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 20, N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W $\frac{1}{4}$, N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 29, S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 30 all in Twp 32- R. 23; that if said Branch be established and constructed, the benefits and damages as set forth in exhibits 91 and 92 hereto attached and made a part hereof be had in lieu of the benefits and damages as set forth in our original report hereto attached and marked exhibit 1, as to each tract of land set forth in said exhibits 91 and 92.

We further recommend that a branch ditch be established and constructed to be known as Branch No. 3 and described as follows: Commencing at a point 180 ft. N. of the center $\frac{1}{16}$ Cor of the N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 32 Twp 32 R. 23, thence running $N\ 88^{\circ}W$ 451 ft. thence $N\ 71^{\circ}W$ 963 ft. thence $N\ 32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 670 ft. thence $N\ 47\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 308 ft. thence $S\ 89^{\circ}W$ 849 ft. thence $N\ 30\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 299 ft. thence $N\ 44^{\circ}W$ 283 ft. thence $N\ 63\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 571 ft. thence $N\ 4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}W$ 649 ft. to sta 16 of Main Witch and crossing the following described lands to wit: N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 32, N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of N.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 31, S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ and S.W $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 30 all in Twp 32 Range 23; That if said Branch be established and constructed the benefits and damages as set forth in exhibit B1 hereto attached and made a part hereof be had in lieu of the benefits and damages as set forth in our original report hereto attached and marked exhibit no 1, as to each tract of land set forth in exhibit B1.

We further recommend that a branch be established and constructed to be known as Branch No 4 and described as follows: Commencing at the N.E corner of the $S\ \frac{3}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of S.E $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 29. Twp 32 R. 24, thence running $S\ 57\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 547 ft. thence $S\ 75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$ 1404 ft to sta 320 of main Witch and crossing

the following described lands to wit: the SE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄ of Sec. 29 and SW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of Sec. 28 all in Twp 32 Range 24. That if said Branch be established and constructed the benefits and damages as set forth in our exhibit C.1 hereto attached and made a part hereof be had in lieu of the benefits and damages as set forth in our original report hereto attached and marked exhibit no 1, as to each tract of land set forth in said exhibit C.1

We further recommend that a Branch ditch be established and constructed to be known as Branch No 5 and described as follows: Commencing at a point N 35¹/₂° W 1100 ft from the S E corner of Sec 28 Twp 32 R. 24, thence S 86° W. 1445 ft thence S 42° W 800 ft thence S 3° W 1027 ft to sds 339+50 of main ditch together with laterals one and two, and crossing the following described tracts of land to wit: The SE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄, NE¹/₄ of SE¹/₄, NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄, SW¹/₄ of SW¹/₄, NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ and SE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄ of Sec 28 and the NE¹/₄ of NW¹/₄ of Sec 33 all in Twp 32 R. 24: That if said Branch No 5 be constructed and established the benefits and damages as set forth in our exhibit D.1 hereto attached and made a part hereof be had in lieu of the benefits and damages as set forth in our original report hereto attached and marked exhibit no 1 as to each tract of land set forth in said exhibit D.1.
