Notice is hereby given, That a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch, the route of which is described as follows:

That during the whole time of said publication affiant was the secretary of the Anoka Herald Publishing Company, which was during said time, and still is, a corporation under the Laws of the State of Minnesota, and the proprietor, printer and publisher of said newspaper.
