For \$25,000.00 to \$30,000.00 bonds of Anoka County Minnesota, issued for the construction of County Ditch No.58 , bearing interest at the rate of FOUR and ONE HALF PERCENT (4½%) per annum payable semi-annually both principal and interest to be payable in the city of Minneapolis, Minnesota. Bonds to be in the denomination of \$1000.00 each , dated March 1st, 1917. and maturing without option of prior payment in equal annual instalments from the sixth to the tenth years inclusive from their date;

We will pay you par and accrued interest from date of bonds to date of delivery to us in Minneapolis and furnish all necessary blank bonds free of charge.

This proposal is made with the understanding that we are granted the option to purchase all bonds issued on County Ditches Nos. 57, 59, and 60, and all other ditches established during the year 1917 at the same price and on the same terms as stated above except that the maturities (with the exception of County ditch #57) shall average ten and one half years or longer.

Bonds are to be a direct obligation of Anoka County, Minnesota, and prior to the delivery of the bonds, we are to be furnished with all papers required by our attorney to establish to his satisfaction that the bonds are legally and regularly issued.

We hand you herewith our certified check in the sum of \$500.00 as an evidence of our good faith in this transaction, to be returned to us in the event our attorney cannot approve the legality of the bonds, otherwise to be used as part payment on the bonds.
