IN THE MATTER OF PUBLIC DITCH IN SECTION 19-32-23 Anoka Co.Minn.

To the Hon. Board of County Commissioners  
of County of Anoka and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned Mary Sullivan respectfully shows to your honorable body that she is the owner in fee and of record of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec.19,Twp.32,R.23 containing ~~2~~ 200 acres according to government survey thereof; that her said land was assessed for more than the sum of \$1400 for the digging and construction of a public ditch to drain the lands in said section, known as Ditch No.58; that she has paid and is paying the same in annual installments with the taxes on said land, and has paid \$434.36 for the installments of 1917 and 1918, under protest, for the reasons stated as follows:

That said ditch was not constructed through her land according to the petition and contract therefor, and is not constructed in a good and workmanlike manner and has wholly failed to drain and will never drain said land of water or otherwise benefit it. That said ditch was unnecessarily dug through a high part of said land making it much less valuable for tillage and farming purposes and otherwise injuring it to her damage in the sum of \$500,

That your petitioner objects to the final payment for the construction of said ditch on the above grounds to the contractor thereof, and prays that said ditch be constructed according to the petition and contract therefor, and that she have such other and further relief as may be just in the premises.
