In the matter of the petition of J. A. Peterson and others for a public ditch in the County of Anoka and State of Minnesota.

Notice is Hereby Given, That a petition has been filed in the office of the county auditor of said county, praying for the construction of a public ditch, the route of which is described as follows:

Main Ditch—Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, Sec. 4, Twp. 32, R. 23, thence southerly through Sec. 4 and continuing southerly and westerly through Sec. 9, said town and range, and continuing westerly through Sec. 8, and continuing southerly through sections 7, 18, 19 and the n¹/₂ of Sec. 30, all of said town and range, and terminating in county ditch No. 57 in the nw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 30, said town and range.

Branch No. 1—Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 3, thence westerly through Sec. 3 and part of Sec. 4 to its outlet in the main ditch in the se¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 4, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 2—Commencing in the ne¹/₄ of sw¹/₄, Sec. 4, thence southeasterly to its outlet in the main ditch in the se¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 4, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 3—Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ of Sec. 4, thence southerly through section 4 and the n¹/₂ of Sec. 9 to its outlet in the main ditch in the sw¹/₄ of nw¹/₄ of Sec. 9, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Lateral 1 of Branch No. 3—Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of the se¹/₄, Sec. 5, thence southeasterly through Sec. 5 and continuing southeasterly to its outlet in Branch No. 3 in the nw¹/₄ of nw¹/₄, Sec. 9, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 4—Commencing in the se¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ or Sec. 9, thence westerly through the w¹/₂ of Sec. 9 and continuing westerly to its outlet in the main ditch in the ne¹/₄ of se¹/₄ of Sec. 8, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 5—Commencing in the se¹/₄ of sw¹/₄, Sec. 8, thence northerly to its outlet in the main ditch in the nw¹/₄ of se¹/₄ of Sec. 8, all in Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 6—Commencing in the nw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄, Sec. 5 thence southerly through Sec. 5 and continuing southerly through the nw¹/₄ of nw¹/₄, Sec. 8 and the ne¹/₄ of Sec. 7, to its outlet in the main ditch in the ne¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 7, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 7—Commencing in the nw¹/₄ of se¹/₄, Sec. 12, Twp. 32, R. 24, thence southeasterly through Sec. 12 and E¹/₂ of Sec. 13, Twp. 32, R. 24, and continuing easterly into the sw¹/₄ of Sec. 18, Twp. 32, R. 23 and terminating in the main ditch in the sw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄ of Sec. 18, Twp. 32, R. 23.

Lateral 1, Branch 7—Commencing in the w¹/₂ of sw¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, Section 7, Twp. 32, R. 23, thence southerly through Sec. 7, nw¹/₄ of Sec. 18, Twp. 32, R. 23, and into Branch No. 7 in the se¹/₄ of ne¹/₄ of Sec. 13, Twp. 32, R. 24.

Lateral 2, Branch 7—Commencing on the south line of se¹/₄ of se¹/₄ of Sec. 7, thence westerly to its outlet in Lateral No. 1 in se¹/₄ of sw¹/₄, Sec. 7, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.

Branch No. 9—Commencing in the sw¹/₄ of sw¹/₄, Sec. 17, thence southerly through Sec. 20 and southwesterly into Sec. 19 to its outlet in the main ditch in the sw¹/₄ of ne¹/₄, Sec. 19, all of Twp. 32, R. 23.
